复旦附中海外基金会(Fudan Fuzhong Overseas Foundation或FFOF)期望通过此书单将使附中学子从多个方面受益。

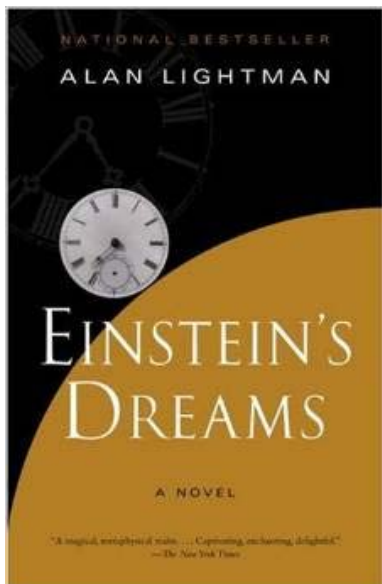

### From Minhua

- Written by an acclaimed MIT astrophysicist, *Einstein's Dreams* is a collection of imagined worlds where time flows differently. When I first read the stories, shortly after graduating with a science degree while busy working on Wall Street, I was struck by the book's instant appeal to my inner curiosity. It also brought a rare sense of tranquility to my mind. The beautiful prose simultaneously explores the laws of physics and those of the society.
- In one world, time is a circle where every moment is to be repeated endlessly in the future. In another, time jumps erratically breaking down causality. In yet another, time flows like a river sometimes visiting the past. The stories stretch the boundaries of human imagination and scientific possibilities.
- This work and its author (first MIT professor with joint appointment in sciences and humanities) is a living testament of how science and humanities can inspire each other. Life flourishes when it is multi-faceted and balanced. As we study and grow in knowledge, we should never forget an education is not complete until the student becomes a complete human being.

### 推荐人：张敏华 (2000届)

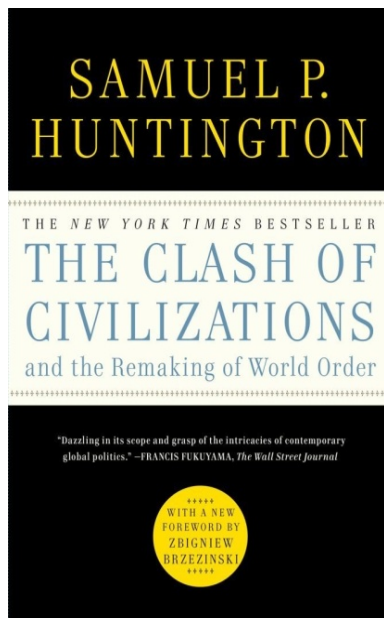

### From Mingyan

- Political scientist Samuel Huntington first proposed the Clash of Civilization theory in 1993, not long after the fall of the Berlin Wall and the collapse of the Soviet Union. Many were wondering at that time what the post-Cold War world will look like without ideological struggle, and Huntington suggested that culture and religion will be the driving force behind future world conflicts. Over the past two decades, this book has become a seminal work in the field of international relations, and is perhaps the most influential book ever written about contemporary global affairs.
- I first encountered this book as a college freshman, and I kept referring back to it not only as I studied political science and anthropology, but also as I travelled around the world. It gave me a new lens to see the world as many co-existing civilizations, each of which evolved out of its unique historical, geographical and cultural context. They have, and will continue to shape each other through both peaceful exchange and brutal warfare. The global community are now faced with challenges different from those of the early 1990s, but Huntington's insights that people everywhere need to learn to coexist in a complex, multipolar, multi-civilizational world remain potent today.
- As you read this book, I challenge you to engage with Huntington's ideas critically. What aspects of his theory help you explain the current world order? What aspects of it are outdated incomplete, or even erroneous? I hope that you will find this process intellectually stimulating. Enjoy reading!

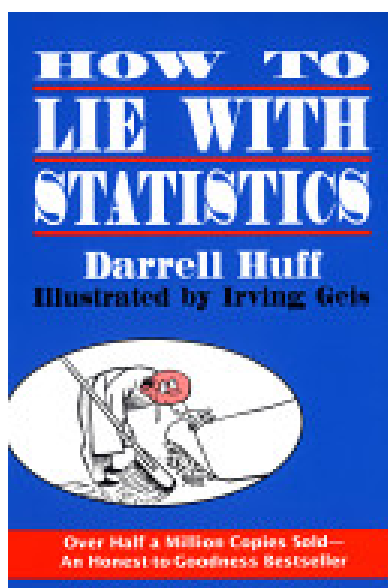
### 推荐人：马鸣燕（2009届）

### From Kelly

- Mark Twain attributed the following famous saying to the British Prime Minister Benjamin Disraeli (1804 to 1881): "Lies, damned lies, and statistics." When attending Fuzhong, I learned basic probability and statistics such as tossing a dice, playing poker card games, and even hearing about the liar's poker. These games prompted me into statistics. After many years, I received the book *How to Lie with Statistics* as a surprise gift on one of my birthdays. Coincidentally, I received two copies from two different friends. It must be that good!
- The book was written in 1954, way before we were born, by a journalist, rather than a mathematician or statistician. This book is one of the bestselling statistics books, with over 500K copies sold in the English edition. The author provided humorous illustrations of proper and improper (and thus "lies") ways of reading numbers and charts. Some of the interpretations might be intentional, but many others were made unintentionally. I recall a simple way to make the slope appearing greater just by rescaling the y-axis of a graph. For those who have not started a formal study in statistics or with minimal knowledge of probability, this book provides an excellent account of uses and misuses of statistics.
- According to *Wall Street Journal*, statistics have become one of the top three professions in the US. Thus, it is certainly worth thinking about the appropriate methods for statistical designs, analyses and interpretations. Therefore, I highly recommend this book as a fun summer read.

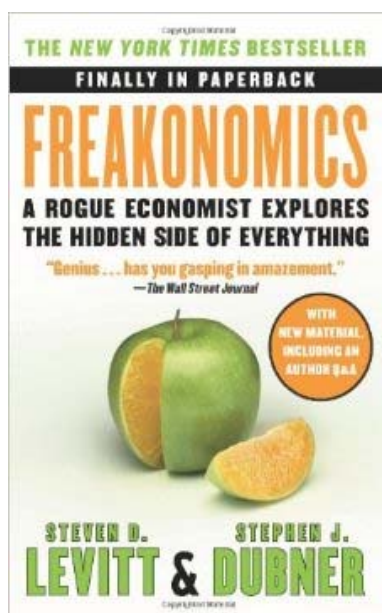
推荐人：邹虹（Kelly Zou）（1988届）

### From Yuxiao

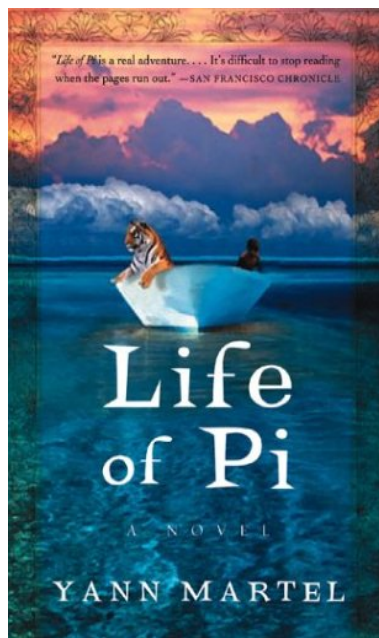

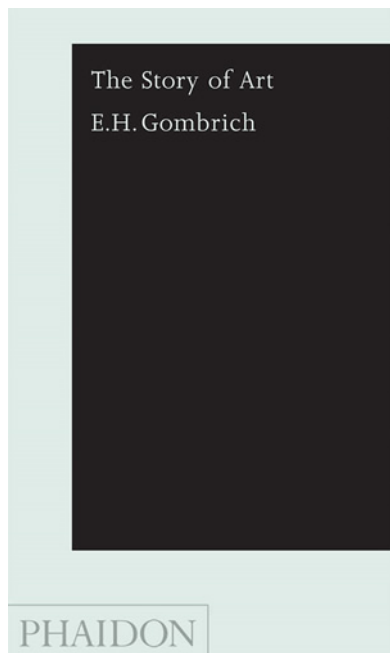
### From Luyi

- *Life of Pi* by Yann Martel tells the story of a teenage Indian boy Piscine Patel, nicknamed Pi, who survived 227 days on the Pacific Ocean after a shipwreck, floating in a lifeboat with the accompany of a Bengal tiger. The tiger, interestingly, has a human name—Richard Parker. Being the son of a zoo owner and a believer in all three religions of Hindu, Christian, and Muslim, our young protagonist demonstrates unique skills and strength of mind in his ordeal and adventure over the sea. *Life of Pi* is inevitably read as an allegory and remains open for interpretation in many different ways. A New York Times book review commented that the book “most strongly recalls Ernest Hemingway's own foray into existentialist parable, *The Old Man and the Sea*”. One of my favorite quotes from Pi comes as follows: “...if [Richard Parker] died I would be left alone with despair, a foe even more formidable than a tiger. If I still had the will to live, it was thanks to Richard Parker.” To me, *Life of Pi* tells a time when we are stripped down to nothing—naked, shelterless, with extreme scarcity of food, drinking water and supplies; and the story asks how we continue to remain human and live in peace with Richard Parker, literally and metaphorically our worst fear and torment, yet paradoxically also the only remaining source of hope and safeguard of sanity. For Pi, memories of the adventure are “nightmares tinged with love”, a statement that well summarizes the complexities of the human condition.
- Despite the rich meanings the author intends to convey, the story itself is told in the casual, vivid, spicy, and sometimes idiosyncratic voice of Pi, the young and charming Indian boy. While Ang Lee’s film adaptation is a beautiful rendition of the story, the original novel will surely offer a heightened excitement of adventure, pushing you beyond the limits of your imagination.

### From Tianyuan

- This is the book that introduced me to art history and influenced me to choose this as a career. First published in 1950, it is revered as the a must-read for beginners and has been wildly popular even until today (it has been translated into thirty languages). In this book, art historian E H Gombrich surveys art all the way from ancient Egypt to twenty century. He imparts basic art historical knowledge such as what is Hellenistic art, and also introduces ways to look at it, such as how to analyze composition and to interpret icons.
- This book sets an example of the kind of writing I want to emulate: it strives to be objective and truth-seeking, yet it feels deeply personal.

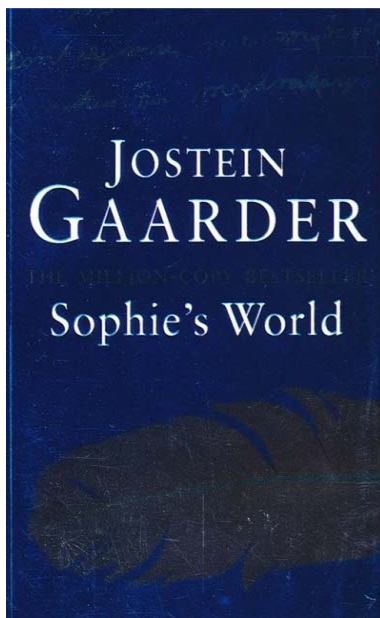

### From Yingzhi

- I first read this book at the age of 11, and then revisited it time and time again even till this day. The subject of philosophy could be daunting even for the sharpest of minds, but it is arguably the most important one in our life: it is deeply intertwined with our high-level thinking of almost everything. High school students are at an age when more complicated thoughts are starting to form and perspectives and premises with which we view the world are established. It is therefore important to keep an open mind and explore the various ideas the wiser men in the ages before us have come to ponder and advance. Where does the world come from? Who are you? These basic questions are nevertheless some of the hardest questions to answer. Gaarder's book centered on a young girl's adventure with her mysterious philosophy teacher, exploring the history of philosophy and its different schools since the Greeks in a light-hearted albeit philosophical way itself. The suspenseful writing draws us in deeper into the subject matter as we read on. The book is almost like a page-turner detective story, yet so rich with details and profound ideas. It is sure to be an unforgettable read for any intellectually curious high school student, as it was for the readers of more than thirty million copies worldwide.

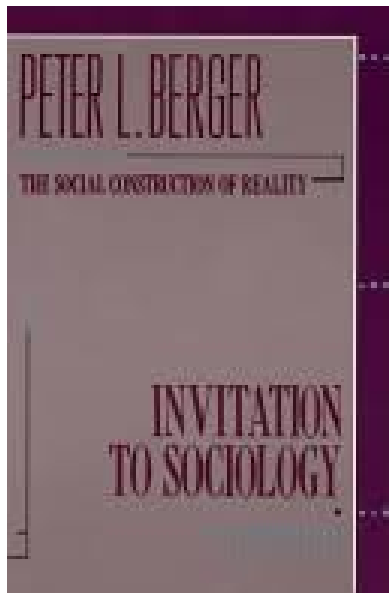
### 推荐人：彭英之（2006届）

- Invitation to Sociology is one of the few books that lead me to the field of sociology during my freshmen year in college. It has also served as a script for me to explain what sociology is and what sociologists can do to family and friends. It is not a standard introduction to sociology textbook, but successfully presents the discipline of sociology to general readers without too much jargon. The sociological imagination can provide people a way to look and think beyond what they have been told and to understand the mechanism of the society. This book serves this purpose well. Upon reading this book, students will get an overview of the discipline of sociology and will also gain new perspectives for understanding the society and the world around them. However, more than forty years has passed since the book first came out. Students need to be aware of the possibly outdated information. With that said, it is still an all-time classic.

为了方便没有阅读英文原著或者用英语写读后感经验的同学们，基金会<sup>1</sup>为大家准备了以下小贴士。和任何模版一样，得心应手后就可以按照自己的阅读习惯加以灵活运用。

### 选择哪一本书？从喜欢的内容入手！

首先，看一下我们书单上每一页书籍封面下面的**分类(Category)**，这本书是关于什么内容的？选择一本和你感兴趣的内容相关的书，不要被书的长度所欺骗。众所周知，哈利波特那么长翻起来也非常快，论语那么短读起来也不容易。**选择你喜欢的内容**会相对不容易因为阅读过程中的生词和语法导致读不下去的窘境。

然后，可以从推荐这本书的校友的背景入手，看看这是不是你以后兴趣发展的方向。也可以从校友写的推荐入手，看看他们对于这本书是如何理解的，为什么要推荐。调查一下这个作者的背景，他是在什么情况下为什么样的读者写的这本书？这本书是什么年代出版的？了解这些信息有助于帮你判断自己要从什么角度来理解这本书。

### 如何阅读？不要让生词难句成为你的障碍！

你需要了解你要读什么和你已经读了什么。看一下目录，大致**了解每一章主题**。读的时候记得**记笔记**和**做小结**。“记笔记”指的不仅是不懂的生词，语法或难句，更包括了你喜欢的语句，作者的论点论据和章节主题。“做小结”则是说每段读完后概括一下段落大意，这样有助于区分有效信息和不必要的细节，更能帮助联系前后文加深理解。如果生词和难句比较多影响了你对于阅读的理解，在查阅字典之后再温故一遍也是有帮助的。

我们读外语书的时候，常常会读了一大段却不知所云的——这很正常。遇到实在读不懂的怎么办？不要紧张，找一个（或者一群）小伙伴一起互相打气一起阅读，读完一章把意思讲给对方听，看大家是否理解得一致。在美国读大学时，大家一起形成**Study Group**来完成作业是常有的事，但最重要的是，大家一起理解了以后每个人**要形成自己的思考**。

### 如何写作？把你的思想表达出来！

首先，确定行文的结构。就内容结构而言，这和中文写作是比较相似的。但有几大注意事项：一是英文写作中，**每一段的首句大都提纲挈领地概括段落主旨**。二是英文写作非常注重对原文的引述。如果你用别人的话来反驳作者的观点，那你必须要提供脚注或者附注。

1. 简要介绍这本书及其作者
2. 你对这本书的看法
3. 为什么这么看？
4. 举例论证
5. 重复步骤2-4
6. 总结

虽然第一次写英文书评不简单，但最重要的是，**不要因为你的英文能力还无法表达出你的思想而灰心！不要放弃！**要知道并非所有美丽的文字都一定要用复杂的词汇或者句式来表达。有时候简单的语句也可以表达出你的想法，仔细想一想，理清思路，你一定可以做到的。

最后，通读一遍你的文章，是否有单词或者语法的错误？修改完以后再看看，你已经做到了！

2006年秋，一个周六的下午，在美国纽约公园大道和五十一街街口的一家“星巴克”里，五位附中校友机缘巧合地坐在了一起。虽然大家毕业年份不同，从1984届到2000届，但大家的共同点，附中留下的那份传统，一种校友文化，一份人文关怀，却把大家聚到了一起。经过一番激烈的讨论之后，复旦附中海外基金会就这么诞生了。从诞辰至今，历经八年，基金会一直都致力于为附中带来更多教育资源，关注附中学子社会责任和人文精神的养成。

经历了美国的大学教育，回忆起过去附中的学习生活，在海外求学或者工作的附中校友们往往会感叹，与大学相比，在高中时的阅读量小很多，尤其是在英语方面。即使是中国最优秀的高中，英语的阅读资源毕竟还是不够充裕，学生也较难养成良好的阅读习惯。然而，书却恰恰是人文精神最好的载体，传承人类五千年来的文化，静静叙述着古往今来，议论着天下时事，为读者开启一扇窗，惊鸿一瞥那灿烂的文明。而英文的资源，由于写作思考方式的不同，往往也会为中国读者提供一个全新视角，令人耳目一新。

顺着这样的思路，基金会于2009年开始动员附中海外校友资源，在附中创建学生资源中心——“知缘阁”。“知缘阁”在创建的时候，其整体构想涵盖三方面。

1. 附中校友志愿者们通过直接进口的方式将海外的书籍资料引入附中，将这部分资源公开放置在“知缘阁”。在每年编纂进口书目时，我们校友志愿者们也力求书籍种类的多样性，涵盖各个学科领域最浅显易懂的经典著作，尽力保证附中的同学们在读过每本书后，都有一份收获与成长。
2. 我们想通过一种比较休闲的环境设定，将“知缘阁”打造成一个开放自由的阅读空间。和附中已有的阅览室不同，“知缘阁”鼓励学生讨论交流阅读时的想法，以思辨的方式探究问题本质，了解世界。
3. “知缘阁”更是为基金会及海外校友与附中学生之间架起了一座思想交流的桥梁，延续校友传统，促进中西方文化在附中的碰撞与融合。至今，我们已在“知缘阁”举办了多次校友访谈，受到了附中学生的的好评。

经过“知缘阁”多年的运营，基金会的校友志愿者们在原有基础上计划以暑期阅读书目的方式，更为互动地将校友的推荐传达给附中的同学们。今年，我们通过附中在海外各个领域工作的校友征集了精选书目，并邀请每位推荐校友结合自己过往经历，写下自己独到的推荐理由。我们借鉴了西方高中的教学方式，将书目以暑期阅读的方式引入附中。经过众多校友志愿者们的努力，也感谢附中英语教研组的帮助及合作，以及学校方面的支持，暑期阅读书目才能在今夏与附中学子见面。

我们真诚地希望校友的推荐以及个人经历能对母校的同学们产生更大的启发。从今夏的一本书开始，收获更多阅读的喜悦，养成思辨的习惯，受到人文主义的熏陶。
